


What is a graduation pathway?

Students in the class of 2023 and beyond will be required to demonstrate postsecondary-readiness through completion of the graduation pathways developed by the State Board of Education. Graduation Pathway requirements will take the place of the graduation exam requirements for the graduating class of 2023 and beyond. Students in prior year cohorts may opt-in to the graduation pathways to satisfy graduation requirements.

What is required to do a graduation pathway?



How many credits do I need to graduate?

Eminence requires students earn 44 credits to graduate.

Do I have to take a foreign language?

If you are doing a Core 40 diploma or a Technical Honors Diploma, then no. If you are doing an Academic Honors Diploma, then yes. You must earn 6-8 credits in a world language. This can be 6 credits in one language or 4 credits each in two languages.

When can I go to Area 30?

Students who are in good standing academically and have enough credits to be considered a junior (at least 24 credits) or senior (at least 36 credits), may enroll at Area 30.

Can I change my schedule if I don't like it?

Student and parent requests to change schedules will be considered on an individual basis during the first two weeks of the semester. Schedule changes will be made for the following reasons: the student needs to add a graduation requirement, a Core 40 requirement, or an Indiana Academic Honors Diploma requirement; the student needs to retake a failed required class; there is an IEP, a doctor's order, or a court order; there is an administrative need or a teacher recommendation.

If I really liked a class, can I take it again?

The easy answer to this question is no. However, there are exceptions. Check with your counselor if you are wondering about a specific class.

If I earn credits before high school, for example, 8th grade Algebra, will the credits count in high school?

Credits earned before high school will count towards the total credits needed for graduation. However, these credits will not count towards the Core 40 curriculum. If you earn credit for Algebra as an 8th grader, you will have to take Geometry, Algebra II, and Pre-Calculus in high school in order to meet the Math requirement for the Core 40 curriculum.

If I am a senior and only need a few more classes to graduate, can I only come part of the day?

No, you must be present all day. The State Board of Education will allow shortened days for highly unusual situations, such as medical emergencies. If you would like to be at school for only half a day, we would most likely put you in Area 30.
